**YOUTH MOVEMENT IN COLOR – COLOR RUN**

**SATURDAY, MAY 16<sup>TH</sup>, 2026**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Youth Movement in Colour – Colour Run will occur on Saturday, 16 May, 2026, between 6:00 pm and 8:00 pm. The following roads will be affected:

**RACE ROUTES:** The run commences behind the Police Recreation Club compound on Headquarters Hill. The participants continue to Fort Hill Road, turn left onto Middle Road, then left onto Orange Valley Road. They turn left onto Parsons Lane, then left onto Palmetto Road. The participants turn left onto Frog Lane, then left onto BFA Way. They turn right into Headquarters Hill and proceed to the finish at the Police Recreation Club field.

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The run will commence on Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 6:00 pm and is expected to conclude by 8:00 pm. The Community Police Team will direct traffic along the route. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the participants. Motorists are asked to follow the Community Police Team's instructions to assist with traffic control.

**ROAD CLOSURES:** There will be no road closures for this event.
