**ROAD CLOSURE FOR BRIDGE DECK REPAIRS
STORE HILL – NEAR THE RAILWAY TRAIL
SMITH’S PARISH**

SATURDAY, 09TH MAY, 2026

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that there will be a road closure on Store Hill only at the railway crossing location, in Smith Parish, to accommodate bridge deck repairs. Residents and their visitors can access Store Hill from Middle Road, and North Shore Road, but they will not be able to travel pass the bridge near the railway trail.

The road closure will occur on Saturday, March 28th, 2026. Working hours will be between 8:00 am and 3:30 pm.

Traffic control will be under the direction of representatives from the Ministry of Public Works and Environment and managed with signage, and barricades.

Motorists are advised to avoid the area, use alternative routes, and note that access will be permitted to residents’ homes but there will be no traffic permitted to drive under the railway bridge position on Store Hill.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
