

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BERMUDA JUNIOR CYCLING INDIVIDUAL TIME TRIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2026

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Individual Time Trial Bicycle Road Race) Order 2026.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Individual Time Trial Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works and Environment roads to be held on Sunday, 14th June 2026.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: The bicycle race commences at the public dock on Harrington Sound Road. The participants proceed east along Harrington Sound Road, then turn right onto Wilkinson Avenue and travel towards the Blue Hole Hill roundabout and head west on North Shore Road towards Flatts Village, then stay left at the junction heading up Middle Road then turn left onto Harrington Sound Road, then proceed to the finish line at the top of the hill on Harrington Sound Road.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 14th June 2026 at 7:30am and is expected to conclude by 9:00am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BERMUDA JUNIOR CYCLING INDIVIDUAL TIME TRIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE) (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2026


The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Individual Time Trial Bicycle Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2026.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Individual Time Trial Bicycle Road Race on the Ministry of Public Works and Environment Roads to be held on Sunday, 14th June 2026.
3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Individual Time Trial Bicycle Road Race.
4. The relevant roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Individual Time Trial Bicycle Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

75 kilometres per hour	The bicycle race commences at the public dock on Harrington Sound Road. The participants proceed east along Harrington Sound Road, then turn right onto Wilkinson Avenue and travel towards the Blue Hole Hill roundabout and head west on North Shore Road towards Flatts Village, then stay left at the junction heading up Middle Road then turn left onto Harrington Sound Road, then proceed to the finish line at the top of the hill on Harrington Sound Road.	7:30am to 9:00am
