**LANE CLOSURE FOR:  
BELCO TRENCH WORK FROM RAILWAY TRAIL AT WHALE BAY ROAD**

**STARTING WEDNESDAY, 17<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2026 THROUGH FRIDAY, 10<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2026**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment advises the motoring public that BELCO trenchwork will commence on Middle Road from the railway trail at the junction of Whale Bay Road in Southampton and advance west to Evans Bay Road.

Works will commence on Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2026 and conclude on Friday, 10<sup>th</sup> of July 2026.

Working hours will be from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of Intelligent Trenching representatives with stop and go signs and possible traffic lights.

**Motorists are advised that, due to the absence of a detour route, delays are expected at this junction.**

The Ministry encourages full cooperation from the public and apologizes in advance for any inconvenience.
