**MONDAY, 8<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2026 THROUGH MONDAY, 27<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2026**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment advises the motoring public that a single-lane closure will be in effect on Middle Road, in Warwick, from Camp Hill junction to Longford Road for paving works to take place.

The single-lane closure commences on Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> June 2026, and continues through Monday, 27<sup>th</sup> July 2026.

Working hours will be from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm daily.

The traffic control for the paving works will be managed by Surface Experts representatives, utilising stop-and-go signs and temporary traffic signals.


The motoring public is advised to use the designated detour routes via South Road and Harbour Road to avoid this section of Middle Road. **Motorists who do not utilize the detour routes should expect traffic delays while traveling through the area.**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages full cooperation from the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may arise.
