**EMERGENCY ROAD CLOSURE  
DUE TO ROAD PAVING WORKS**

**MONDAY, 22<sup>nd</sup> JUNE 2026**

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform the motoring public that there will be a road closure on Middle Road in Warwick to allow for the road paving works to take place.

The road closure is just east of St Anthony's Church to entrance to Tatem School.

East bound motorists will detour via Burnt House Hill and onto Harbour Road then return to Middle Road via Tamarind Vale.

West bound Motorists will detour via Tamarind Vale and onto Harbour Road then return to Middle Road via Burnt House Hill.

During the road closure there will be access for buses and for residents.

The road closure will commence on Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2026.

Working hours will be weekdays from 7:30 am through to 5:00 pm.

Traffic control will be under the direction of Surface Experts Limited and their Works representatives with be using barricades, signs, and cones.
