**PHASE III COMMENCING TUESDAY, 1ST SEPTEMBER 2026
THROUGH SUNDAY, 27TH SEPTEMBER 2026**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment advises the motoring public that installation of the Swing Bridge pre-construction detour route is entering Phase III; implementation of One-Way System and construction of mini-roundabout.

This detour route is being constructed in 3 phases.

Phase I: Closing off road at Gate #1 no access from roundabout to Park to construct the temporary bus turnaround area. (Park access via Southside Road)
Completed

Phase II: Construct Mini-roundabout at Gate #2 (Waller's Point Road)
To be completed first week of September 2026

Phase III: Temporary relocating bus stop from east of existing roundabout to south along wall to establish a "One-Way" roundabout system through bus lane & construct mini-roundabout
Tuesday, 1st September 2026 through Sunday, 27th September 2026

These dates are tentative and may vary due to weather or other concerns.

Working hours will be from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of the Ministry of Public Works and Environment representatives with barricades, cones and stop and go men.

For the "One-Way" roundabout system, the bus lane will be utilized for westbound traffic and the bus stop at Gate number one will be relocated to the grass verge along the Kindley Field Park wall. Signs will be placed to indicate the location.

Once the mini-roundabout is constructed, all traffic will be diverted through Kindley Field Park. All buses then will utilize the bus turnaround area within Kindley Field Park.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages full cooperation from the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may arise.
