ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA TRIATHLON ASSOCIATION – AON LTD MIXED TEAM RELAY TRIATHLON)
(VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2026

SUNDAY, 20TH SEPTEMBER 2026

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Triathlon Association – AON Ltd mixed team relay triathlon) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2026.
- 2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicle’s attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda triathlon Association on roadways by Clear Water beach, St Davids to be held on Sunday, 20th of September 2026.
- 3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda triathlon Association Road Race.
- 4. The relevant roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Triathlon Association Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

55 kilometers per hour	The time trial for the Junior teams age 7-10 Years and Senior team 11+ category the triathlon commences and concludes at the car park opposite Clearwater Beach. SUNDAY, 20th SEPTEMBER 2026

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Bermuda Triathlon Association will be holding a road race on: Sunday 20th September 2026 between the hours of 8.00am & 10:15am at Clear Water Beach. Please note the following:

- RACE ROUTE:** The triathlon commences and concludes at the car park opposite Clearwater Beach. The participants proceed North along Cooper's Island Road until reaching the roundabout. They exit West onto Southside Road and continue Southside Road to the turnaround. The participants will turn around to continue East on Southside Road. They proceed to the roundabout, where they exit onto Cooper's Island Road to the finish line.
- TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The triathlon will commence on Sunday, September 21st, 2025, at 8:00 am and is expected to conclude by 10:15 am. Police Officers and Race Marshals will be present to direct traffic along the route. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. Motorists are asked to follow the instructions given by the Police Officers and Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.
- ROAD CLOSURES:** Please be advised that all roads along the race route will be closed for the duration of the event. This includes Southside Road Tommy Fox Road, and the Pepper Hall Road/Tommy Fox Road intersection.

The Ministry wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
