**SINGLE LANE CLOSURE FOR VEGETATION CLEARANCE
PALMETTO ROAD (EAST OF THE GLEBE ROAD BRIDGE)
PEMBROKE PARISH**

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 28TH, 2026 TO TUESDAY, OCTOBER 6TH, 2026

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that there will be a single lane closure on Palmetto Road, just East of the Glebe Road Bridge, in Pembroke Parish, to accommodate vegetation clearance.

The lane closure will commence on Monday, September 28th, 2026, weather permitting, and remain in place until Tuesday, October 6th, 2026. Working hours will be between 9:30 am and 3:30 pm.

Traffic control will be under the direction of representatives from Abundance Horticulture.

Motorists are advised to avoid the area and use alternative routes via Marsh Folly Road, Bishop Spencer Road and Roberts Avenue.

Motorists travelling through the closure area should expect delays and exercise caution.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
